If you plan to attend online, here is a list of items we encourage you to gather so you are ready to participate in the ritual and banquet: sliced lamb on a lettuce leaf, grapes, cheese cubes, orange segments, black and green olives, dates, flat bread/cracker/matza, water, wine or grape juice, a bible and several candles. Set places as formally as feasible to create a sacred environment.
