The Showrunner Camp is a one-week immersion program in television production for middle and high school students. Participants ("crew") learn the skills needed to broadcast a live two-hour music concert, recorded in front of a studio audience. During the five day camp, the crew receive instruction from industry professionals and practice those skills is a working studio (making a live, public broadcast each day). crew members become their own production company which, by week's end, self-sufficiently produces (with on-screen credit) an episode of Juneau Live! Studio's most popular series (10,000+ views), Alaska Music One Presents with at least four major, local bands, in front of a studio audience.



The tuition-free camp is open to middle to high school students (including those who will be starting middle school next fall and those who are graduating high school this year). The program will be able to accommodate some special needs. The program is limited to 25 crew to ensure every crew member can fully experience all aspects of the program.
